

**World Association Plastics Packaging for Dangerous Goods ICPP elects new President**

Bad Homburg, 3rd June, 2014 – At its General Assembly in May, the ICPP International Confederation of Plastics Packaging Manufacturers elected a new President for four years.

Jerry Geyer, Greif, Inc./USA, was unanimously elected President by the delegates from Europe, America, Asia and Africa. In compliance with a rotational system he follows Benoît Cheval from Sotralentz Packaging SAS/France after four years of presidency.

The Vice-Presidents Chris Lind, Mauser Corp./USA and Dave Tatz, Megapack/South Africa were unanimously confirmed for another four-year mandate.

According to the statutes of the association, the ICPP-secretariat is hosted by IK Industrievereinigung Kunststoffverpackungen e.V., the German Association for Plastics Packagings and Films. IK managing director Dr. Jürgen Bruder is also General Secretary of the international organisation. ICPP is accredited with consultative status at the United Nations and attends regularly the meetings of the UN Sub-Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods in Geneva.
